

Pursuant to the Decree on the concession and on the method for the implementation of performing public service obligation relating to the activity of the electricity market operator (Official Gazette of RS, No. 39/15, 121/21 – ZSROVE, 172/21 – ZOEE; hereinafter: the Regulation), Official Gazette of RS, No. 121/21, 189/21, 121/22 – ZUOKPOE and 102/24 and the Decision of the Government of the Republic of Slovenia No. 36000-13/2022/3 of 19th October 2022, Borzen, d. o. o., as the Slovenian Electricity Market Operator publishes the following information:

1. Contribution for the functioning of the Electricity Market Operator

The contribution for the operation of the electricity market operator is defined in Article 24 of the Regulation and is intended to cover the costs of the electricity market operator related to the performance of public economic service tasks. The contribution is paid by final customers for each individual metering point, based on the active electrical energy consumed (kWh). The final customer pays this contribution as a separate item on the monthly network charge invoice.

2. Payment for registration of Closed Contracts

The amount of the fee is determined in Article 25 of the Regulation. Pursuant to the second indent of the first paragraph of Article 95 of the Electricity Supply Act (Official Gazette of the Republic of Slovenia, No. 172/21; hereinafter: ZOEE), members of a balancing scheme acting on the selling side in concluded contracts are required to pay the fee, with the exception of providers of public economic services referred to in Articles 45, 69 and 94 of this Act, as well as energy exchanges.

The payments of balancing scheme members depend on the volume of registered concluded contracts, excluding concluded contracts for electricity imports, and are calculated based on the reported quantities in MWh.

3. Contribution for the functioning of the Centre for RES/CHP support

Within the framework of the public economic service, the electricity market operator also performs the activities of the Support Centre (in accordance with Article 18 of ZSROVE), which include several tasks, among others support schemes and a contact point for renewable energy sources. The activities of the Support Centre are financed from support funds as defined in points (a) and (b) of the third paragraph of Article 16 of ZSROVE.

4. Other sources of financing

The activities of the public economic service may also be financed, pursuant to Article 27 of the Regulation, from other payments by users, in accordance with the third indent of the first paragraph of Article 95 of ZOEE.
