

Pursuant to the Decree on the concession and on the method for the implementation of performing public service obligation relating to the activity of the electricity market operator (Official Gazette of RS, No. 39/2015), valid from 1st July 2015, and the Decision of the Government of the Republic of Slovenia No. 36001-11/2010/4 of 23rd September 2010, Borzen, d. o. o., as the Slovenian Electricity Market Operator publishes the following information:

1. Contribution for the functioning of the Electricity Market Operator

The contribution for the functioning of the Electricity Market Operator is intended to cover part of the costs of the Market Operator's tasks stipulated by law. The supplement to the network charge is an integral part of the price for the use of networks and is charged on the basis of the quantity of electricity consumed.

2. Payment for registration of Closed Contracts

In accordance with second indent of the first Paragraph of Article 98 of the Energy Act (EZ-1) payment shall be due from members of the balance scheme included in closed contracts on the supply side, except in the case of providers of services of general economic interest referred to in Articles 54, 78 and 97 of this Act and the energy exchange. The payments depend on the energy volume of registered closed contracts.

3. Contribution for the functioning of the Centre for RES/CHP support

Activities of the Centre for RES/CHP Support are specified in Article 376 of the Energy Act. They include the administration of the Support Scheme for the production of electricity from renewable sources and high-efficiency cogeneration of heat and power as well as other tasks stipulated by law.

4. Other sources of financing

Other services that are performed on the basis of the Energy Act (EZ-1) and statutory acts and are required for the efficient implementation of the public service obligation, such as provision of data on request, may be charged separately.
