

Slovenian Feed-in Support System for Electricity from RES and High-efficiency CHP

- PERIODIC REPORT –

Period from 1. 1. 2026 to 30. 6. 2026

Date of report: 20. 07. 2026

1. Power plants in the system

As of June 30, 2026, 2,667 units with a total installed net capacity of 480.4 MW were included in the support scheme, compared to 3,162 units with a total capacity of 492,8 MW at the end of June 2025. Of all units, 2,306 operated under the old support scheme based on previously determined reference costs, while 361 units were included in the scheme under the EZ-1 Energy Act, either through public calls for applications or by transitioning from the old support scheme. The largest share among the generation facilities included in the support scheme consists of solar power plants and CHP plants using fossil fuels. A more detailed overview of the structure of generation facilities by number of units and installed capacity is presented in the following table.

2. Support payments

In the first six months of 2026, a total of EUR 54.61 million in support payments was disbursed, representing an increase of approximately 7.7% compared to the corresponding period of 2025, when EUR 50.71 million was disbursed. During the same period, electricity generation increased by approximately 42.4%. Total electricity generation amounted to 639.68 GWh, compared to 449.07 GWh in the corresponding period of 2025.

The average support payment in the first six months of 2026 amounted to EUR 85.4/MWh, representing a decrease of approximately 24.4% compared to the corresponding period of 2025, when it amounted to EUR 112.93/MWh.
